NOTIFICATION

No. DTP/MUN-43/2010-11/4290-01.—WHEREAS, the Government of Arunachal Pradesh in exercise of powers conferred by Sub-Section(I) of Section 4 of the Arunachal Pradesh Municipal Act, 2007 (Act No. 4 of 2008) vide notification issued vide Memo No. DTP/MUN-43/2010-11 dated 24th August, 2010 had constituted Pasighat Municipal areas.

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Arunachal Pradesh in exercise of powers conferred by sub-rule (I) of Rule (3) of the Arunachal Pradesh Delimitation of Ward Rules, 2010 had constituted the Municipal Wards for Pasighat Municipality vide Notification No. DTP/MUN-43/2010-11 dated 15th June, 2012, and accordingly objections/suggestions in this regard to the proposed Municipal Wards were invited from any individual or department or anybody within a period of 30 days from the date of the issue of such notice.

AND WHEREAS, 9 numbers of claims and objections were received, considered and disposed off by the Deputy Commissioner, Pasighat as intimated vide his letter No. PSG/MUN-01/12/1268 dated 24th August, 2012.

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Arunachal Pradesh in exercise of the powers conferred under Sub-section (I) of Section (3) of the Arunachal Pradesh Municipal Election Act, 2009 (Act No. 4 of 2009) read with sub-rule (d) of Rule 9 of the Arunachal Pradesh Municipal Delimitation of Ward Rules, 2010 hereby determines the limitation of Wards of the Pasighat Municipality as indicated in the Schedule-I and II of the notification.

NOW THEREFORE, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh in pursuance to Rule 10 of the Arunachal Pradesh Municipal Delimitation of Wards Rules, 2010 hereby publishes the said order in the Arunachal Pradesh Gazette.

1.	North —	The Northern Boundary starts from the culvert over the Tebo Stream at GTC area and it goes at 10 degree direction (approximately) up to the point where it reaches Siang River. Then it turns towards south-east and runs along the right bank of Siang.
	East —	The Eastern boundary starts from the North - East corner till it reaches the Siang-Sibo Korong confluence and at 68.21° turns south-west.
	South —	From confluence it goes south-west upstream of Sibo Korong till the new RCC bridge over Sibo Korong.
	West —	It goes along the slope of JN College bisecting the NH52 and meet at Tebo stream.
2.	North —	The Northern Boundary starts from the point where road leading to JNC Upper Campus takes a sharp bend then run south along the slope meeting ward 1 near Tebo stream and continues till it meets Sibo Korong near the Bridge. At 65.12° it runs along the Sibo Korong till the Siang River confluence.
	East —	The Eastern boundary starts from the rivers confluence till it reaches the Komlighat Jetty point.
	South —	From Komlighat Jetty it goes south-west along the NH52 till Medical Charali and turns south upto Men's Health Trainees Hostel road Junction and along Siang Model School street encompassing RWD Colony and run along PLT Road upto Mirmir Charali.
	West —	The Western boundary starts from PLT-Pasighat Balek Road junction popularly known as Mirmir Charali near Microwave Station at the south - west corner of the Township and turns at 310 degree angle towards Sibo-korong and meets Sibo-korong river covering the Central Donyi Polo Gangging. Then it runs across Sibo-Korong river in continuity upto the South corner of JNC acquired area. Then it turns towards West - North direction along Siying Korong upto a distance of 3 kms covering JNC upper and lower campus including PHE Water Treatment Plant and College boundary pillar.
3.	North —	It starts from PLT road junction near RWD colony along SFS school street towards NHPC colony upto Biological park 4-route junction.
	East —	Thereupon it run southward meeting Pasighat-Balek Road in 4-route junction popularly known as Mirmir Tinali.
	South —	The South West boundary run straight till it again terminates at Mirmir Charali
	West —	Mirmir Charali Point.

4.	North —	The Northern Boundary line starts from Biological Park Junction and goes north-east covering UD office, High Region Kali Mandir area, RWD colony behind General Hospital.
	East —	At junction near Town Club it runs south-west covering Power Transformer Yard all along the road leading to D.Ering HSS School and turns toward Post Office-AIR junction covering Sri Ninong Ering's (MP) residence and Doordarshan Residential Complex.
	South —	Private plots with commercial establishment behind N.Ering's Residence and ends at Mirmir Tinali junction.
	West —	It runs along the NHPC complex road encompassing Forest office and Forest Colony Primary School till it meets at Biological Park Junction.
5.	North —	The Northern Boundary line starts from Medical Charali junction and goes north-east along NH52 till Gandhi Middle School Junction and then goes south along NH52.
	East —	From the point near Central Water Commission office covering Buddhist Gompa, Museum and District Library the ward boundary turns westward.
	South —	It follows the road leading to Town Club covering DST colony, Education Colony and then along Siang Guest House Road covering PHED colony and PHED Enquiry Office.
	West —	The Boundary runs parallel to BSNL office and at. AIR office along Post office road it meets Ward 4 southern boundary.
6.	North —	The Northern Boundary line starts from Gandhi Middle School junction and goes north-east along PI Line road till Komlighat Jetty.
	East —	From Komlighat point the boundary goes south-east along the River Siang embankment upto a distance of 749 mtrs and then turn west near Jarku School road.
	South —	From Jarku Primary School junction it follows the road in the manner of arc till it meets the road leading to dumping ground. It runs south-west covering Airfield-area meeting NH52 near Banskota Mela ground.
	West —	The western boundary straight along NH52 bisecting IGJ HS School and School play ground upto the junction of Gandhi Middle School.
7.	North —	It starts from 4-route junction Near AIR station covering SP's Residence BSNL office and Centenary Park follows the road leading to Pasighat Bazar.
	East —	It runs right along the arterial road of Bazar and covering Lal Bahadur Shastri School, Naamghar and Balaji Temple and then run southward behind Market Square and excluded WRC area of K. Borang and meet NH52 encompassing Police station, Jail and meet Ramro Nallah.
	South —	The boundary runs upstream along Ramro Nallah covering few plots of Agricultural land and bisects Ramro Nallah again near Fishery Office complex.
	West —	It goes northwards covering Fishery pond, Mirku village Cemetery , DC office Complex and ends at AIR station road junction.
8.	North —	It starts from Junction near Siang Guest House covering IB area and then follows road leading to IGJ HS School and meets NH52 near Museum.
	East —	It runs with the ward boundary of Ward 6 upto the Residence of Denong Tamuk covering Arshang School and adjoining commercial area.
	South —	From the NH52 junction it covers the area of Upper Banskota/Green Valley and meets the road going to Bazar near Tasung Commercial Building.
	West —	It goes northwards covering Hotel Ane, Padung Commercial Building, Apex Bank and meets the ward boundary near Siang Guest House.
9.	North —	It starts from Junction near Tasung Commercial Building encompassing area behind Market Square, West Green Valley following the boundary of ward 8 till it meets NH52.
	East —	It covers the area of Mela ground south wards and turns westwards meeting with the road leading to SS Mission Road.
	South —	Along SS Mission road it runs north ward covering Sadhuram Rice Mill and then along NH52 turns south-west terminating near the junction of M. Borang Oil Depot.
	West —	The boundary follows Ward 7 boundary till it again meet near Tasung Commercial Building.

	10.	North —	It starts from Junction near Tako Dabi Residence and follows road leading to Jarku—Muriline colony along the Ward 6 Boundary.
		East —	It starts from road coming from Jarku leading to Siang River and follows the flow the river approximately upto a distance of 1050 metre till the Municipal Boundary near Pilloomukh area.
		South —	From Municipal Boundary limit near Pilloomukh area it runs South-West approximately upto a distance of 690 metre meeting the ward boundary of Ward 11 behind SS Mission Bamboo groove.
		West —	It follows Ward 11 meeting the culvert over Pane stream and then turns south-west upto Buishi Yada motor service centre in the SS Mission Road and turns north meeting the ward boundary of Ward 9 and follow NH- 52 terminating at the Starting reference point near the junction of Tako Dabi residence.
	11.	North —	It starts from Junction near Apex Bank within the Ering Commercial Complex and runs north-east upto the road leading to SS Mission which it follows covering Maruti Workshop and some commercial plots and again runs north-east meeting Pane Nallah in Muriline.
		East —	The boundary run along the Pane Nallah southward covering plantation behind SS Mission and rejoin the main road within the SS Mission area covering including some agricultural field.
		South —	It follows the natural drainage pattern of Ramro Nallah upto the culvert over NH52 near Judicial Jail.
		West —	From the point it goes northward with the NH52 where it rejoins the Junction near Apex Bank.
	12.	North —	From the upper boundary of the industry area it goes towards east covering APST colony and meets Ramro Korong at the back side of APST colony.
		East —	From the meeting point at Ramro Korong it goes southwards and ends at south corner of All India Radio Complex at 3 mile.
		South —	AIR Complex at 3 Mile.
		West —	The western boundary line starts from South corner of All India Radio Complex at 3 mile and runs parallel to Pasighat - Jonai road (NH-52) towards Pasighat Town covering All India Radio Complex, VTI, Gumin Nagar, DIET, Kendriya Vidyalaya, Juvenile Remand Home, FCI Godown upto industry area at Sawmill.
